Sir/Madam,


As you are aware that online proposals are invited from AICTE approved Colleges/Institutes and University Departments who run AICTE approved programmes for grant of Scholarship under various Schemes. Scholarships under these schemes are directly transferred in the bank account of the eligible students through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Scheme. These schemes are to be transferred to National Scholarship Portal for the aforesaid purposes. However, under the scheme of PG Scholarship, Scholarship is released through Public Financial Management System (PFMS).

An observation has been made by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education (Scholarship Division) vide its letter number 1-44/2017-NS-1(NSP) dated 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 that many Institutions had not verified the online applications, thereby making the students ineligible for grant of Scholarships. In order to avoid such instances it has been emphasized through aforesaid letter dated 28.07.2017 that concerned Institutions should verify online applications on priority basis so that students are not deprived of the scholarships. Institutions may also give wide publicity about the National Scholarship Portal and the Schemes on their respective websites.

In view of the above, it is requested that the data/documents of the students uploaded by the students should be verified on priority basis. The attendance of the students, wherever applicable, should also be forwarded by 10<sup>th</sup> of succeeding month to avoid the uncalled for delay in disbursement of Scholarship.


Madam / Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 31.05.2017 on the above subject and to say that for the year 2017-18 the self-declaration of Income has been done away with.

2. Now, for the year 2017-18, the 'Income Certificate', issued by any Competent Authority is a mandatory requirement for applying for any scholarship scheme for 2017-18. Where the documents are uploaded, the 'Income Certificate' shall also be required to be uploaded on National Scholarship Portal (NSP). In all other cases, where uploading of documents is not required, the Income Certificate shall be produced before the school/institute for verification of the applicant's online application on NSP. The 'Standard Operating Procedure', issued by MoMA to States/UTs and 'Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)' placed on National Scholarship Portal already mention about the mandatory requirement of 'Income Certificate.'

3. All States/UTs may please see for immediate necessary action in the matter.
